Booth Rules? Booths must be in good taste (no profanity or excess gore) Fund raising ideas are up to the creativity of the students. If food is sold only pre-packaged items or bottled drinks can be used. Fund raising concepts will be limited. Booth space and concepts are on a first come first serve basis subject to approval. (we do not want 10 booths all selling soda)

Booth Decorating Contest- KLUC will provide prizes for the Most Original, Scariest, and Best of Show. The KLUC DJ's and other "celebrities" are to judge the contest. GameWorks is donating passes to the House of the Dead Experience!!

Operation of the event: R&J Productions provides the location, registers and monitors the participating entrees.

Promotion: KLUC is the media sponsor providing radio spots, a live broadcast and donating the prizes. CLASS Magazine will provide 2 full page adds in Sept. and Oct. issues to reach all students. Individual schools are asked to promote the event with announcements to support their own participating student groups.
